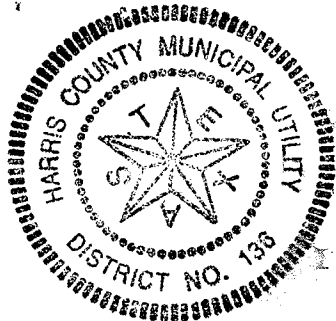
NOTICE
