

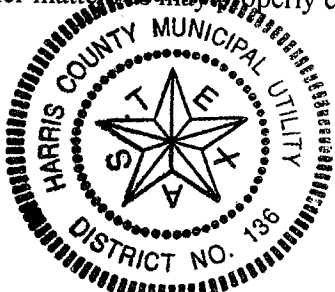


NOTICE
